Edwin and Anne Kibathi relocated to London from the Presbyterian Church of East Africa in Kenya in 2006 to reach out to the large East African expatriate community in the UK and begin a church planting ministry.

The church plant was established in the Stratford area of East London and has continued to grow. The congregation has over 100 adult members, with many more children and young people attending. They meet for worship services every Sunday afternoon in East London and offer a warm welcome to newcomers and visitors. In addition, the congregation has a Women's Guild, Men's Fellowship, Sunday School and youth group, each of which takes an active part in the church services during the year.

In recent years, two PCEA fellowship groups have started in Luton and Reading, with East African expats gathering on Sundays for worship and teaching. Edwin and Anne also engage with the wider East African expatriate community in the UK and seek to support people pastorally.
