There is the opportunity to contribute to a farewell gift for Sonya.


Envelopes are in the pews and on the vestibule table.

Prayer points

The Church in Nepal continues to flourish with the majority of Nepali Christians worshipping and fellowshiping in local Nepali structures and networks. The Church is growing in maturity and community engagement, but prayer is still needed for Nepal's Christians to have discernment, courage and faithfulness in living out their faith every day.

Children and young people make up two-thirds of Nepal's population, which is one of the world's youngest and fastest growing. Most live in rural areas, deprived of education and opportunity. Illiteracy is widespread. Pray for changes that offer children and young people hope and a future, particularly for girls.

Thank God for the PCI representatives who were able to attend the United Mission to Nepal (UMN) General Assembly in May. Pray for the ongoing relationship with UMN and individuals and ask that God would continue to make the partnership as strategic and mutually beneficial as possible.

Pray for the many projects being run by the United Mission to Nepal to tackle poverty in a number of areas of the country, including the ongoing children's education project in the Bahjang District focused on improving teacher training and the provision of better classroom facilities for the children.
