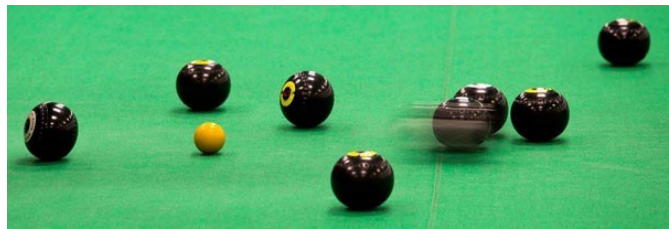

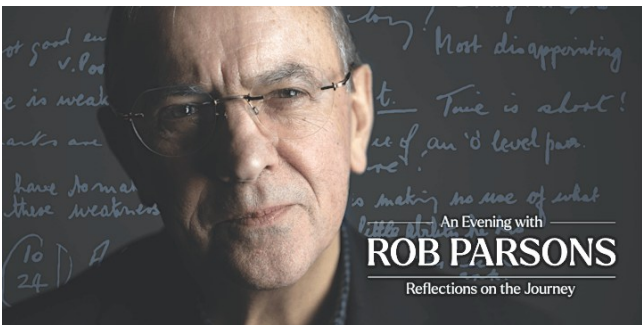


Tuesday evening Bowls has finished for the year, however Friday morning Bowls will continue for another few weeks.

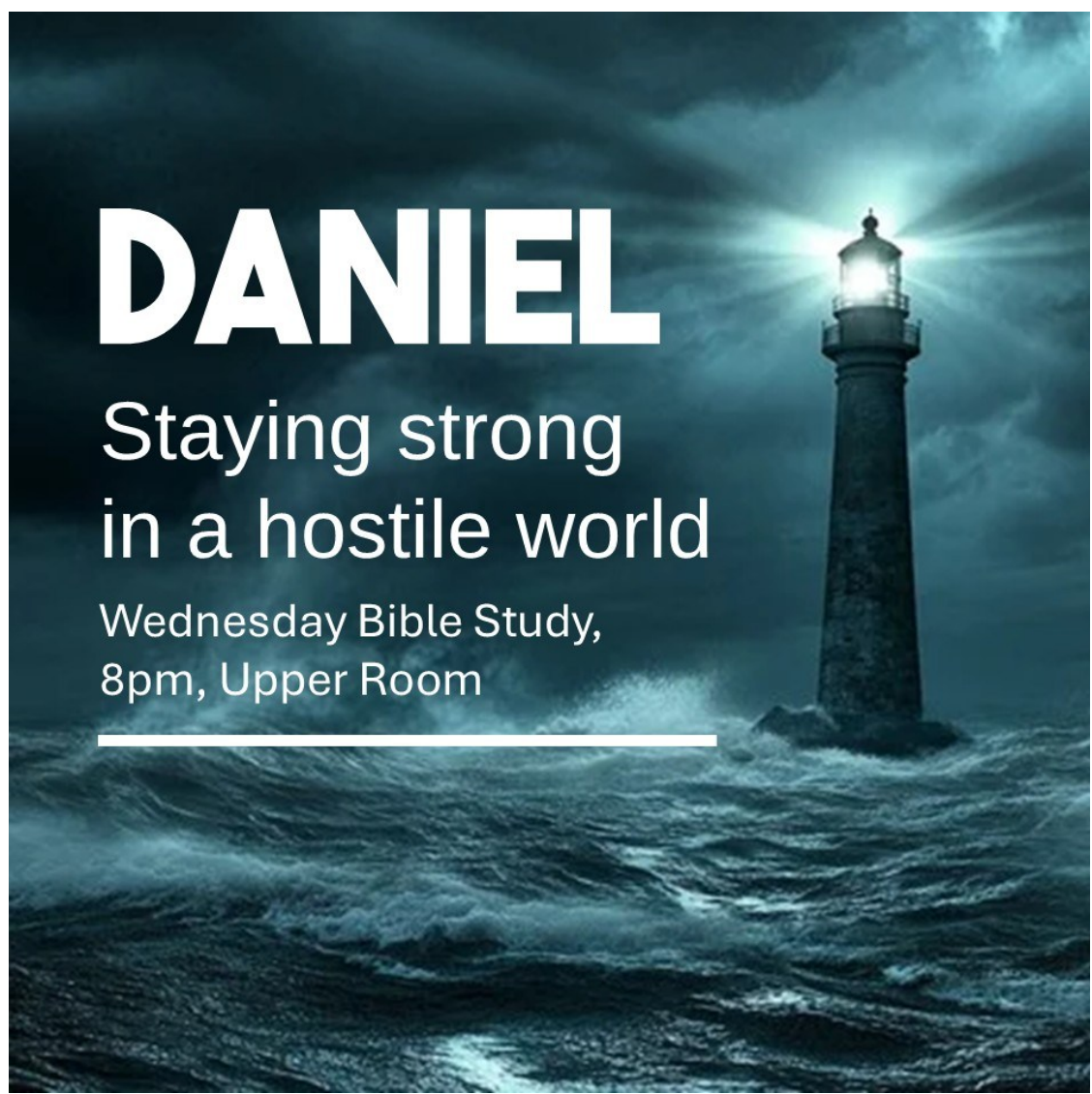
