## ***Ministry Update***

Greetings, dear brothers and sisters. Our God has given me a wonderful gift, to preach the Holy Scriptures to people. I try to do my best to serve with reverence and dedication. In our region, many churches lack ministers, and there are also churches where there is only one preacher, or sometimes none at all. Therefore, my family and I have devoted ourselves to serving such churches. We stay in contact with church leaders and arrange ministry visits.

During the last 3 months we have visited churches in the following villages: Chuluk, Grigorovka, Sadovoe, Obrezha, Palaria, Yablona, Fundury, and Oshanany.

Recently, during the Easter season, I had the opportunity to visit several villages with a special evangelistic programme. For example, in the village of Obrezha, we held a children's service where I shared the Good News about the wonderful resurrection of Jesus Christ. In the village of Fundury we participated with our programme during the service, where local residents were invited. I preached to them about the resurrection of Jesus Christ and told how people can have eternal life by recognising their sinful life and repenting. After the service, over a cup of tea and coffee, we discussed questions that interested them. It was a wonderful time for evangelism, their hearts were open, and they were eager for fellowship. Glory to God that He still knocks on people's hearts.

In addition, I lead a weekly Bible study for brothers on Tuesdays in our local church.

As a deacon of the local church, I also visit the sick and elderly in the area entrusted to me by the church.

### ***Ministry plans***

The season of summer camps is approaching, so we are beginning the preparations. We are developing the programme, preparing helpers and leaders, organising equipment, and seeking opportunities and sponsors.

Last year, we were able to organise a 5-day daytime camp in the city park, which was attended by 200–250 children. Some of these children had never heard about God before and were very interested in the message. Therefore, this year we are planning to organise a similar camp and hope that even more children will attend. It will be a wonderful opportunity for evangelism among children and their grandparents and parents. Younger kids come with their grandmothers or parents.

During the summer, we also plan to go into yards around the city to hold evangelistic outreaches. We will invite everyone to gather in a large yard with children's play areas. While the children are playing, we will share the Gospel with parents, grandparents, and young people. Then we will tell Bible stories to the children and distribute Christian literature. We need to seek permission to do it all from the local Mayor's office. Pray for it. Last year they were pretty friendly and open.

For my family, for everyone to be healthy and that we would have sufficient provision so we can devote our time fully to ministry.

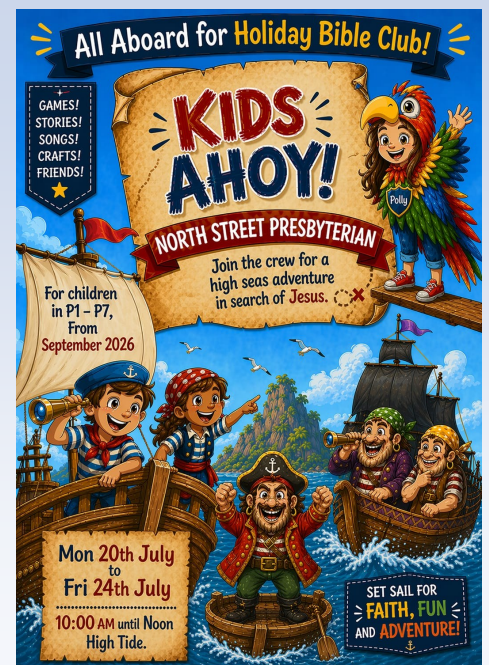
For the upcoming camps. For God to send as many children as possible, for them to hear about the wonderful salvation and accept God in their hearts.
